



I've been a judge since 1997 and I have bred Belgian shepherds.

I'm approved for all breeds in the FCI-groups 1, 2, 5, 9 and 10 and as Best in show judge and Junior Handling.

Beside those groups I'm also judging breeds in groups 3, 6, 7 and 8.

I have already judged a lot of International shows and breed specialties in most European countries, in Israel, the United States of America, Argentina and Australia. I also gave seminars in some of these countries especially on Belgian shepherds and Junior Handling.

Due to my judging a lot abroad I have stopped breeding because I have no more time for this.

Of course I still have dogs at home : 2 Tervurens adult males, 1 puppy Tervuren and 1 smooth Griffon. All the adults became International and / or World Champion.

Besides judging I'm also involved in different Belgian committees : vice-president of the Club for Belgian, Brussels and smooth Griffons and Papillons and Phalènes, president of section 4A (Dogshows) of the Belgian kennel club, committee member of the judges' qualification committee and committee member of the Belgian Kennel Club.

So you could say that I'm a real dog person.
